Conditions of Certification (Conduct and Ethics) – Adopted January 19th, 2009

As a Certified Post Tensioning Ironworker, I will adhere to the following code of conduct:

- I will not misrepresent or knowingly deceive others concerning my experience or my capabilities.
- I will not knowingly violate the requirements of any project specifications or requirements related to the installation, stressing, or grouting of the post-tensioning system.
- I will perform my work in a manner...
 - so as to place the safety and welfare of my coworkers above all other considerations.
 - so as to protect the nearby general public, property and the environment.
- I will not knowingly violate any safety related regulations, warnings or instructions related to the installation, stressing, or grouting of the post-tensioning operations, whether these be generally recognized safety standards, OSHA standards, or instructions from the system supplier or equipment manufacturer.
- I will not misuse or misrepresent my certification card or the Post Tensioning Ironworker Certification logo, which are the property of Evaluation and Certification Services, LLC, and I understand that I must return the card to ECS immediately if required to do so.

I understand and agree that my failure to provide accurate and complete information in my application and any work experience affidavits, or my failure to abide by this Post Tensioning Ironworker Code of Ethics shall constitute grounds for the rejection of my application or the denial or revocation of my certification.
